


Instrument Return Procedures – End of Year



Great Job at your concert!!!! We've had a wonderful year and we can't wait for you to come back next year!

4th Grade, follow these steps to let Mr. Mulcahy and Ms. Maliszewski know if you're playing in Band and Strings Next year!

1. Fill out this Google Form: <http://goo.gl/forms/goXOUMhB3Z>
2. Keep instrument over the summer!! Mr. Mulcahy and Ms. Maliszewski will give you summer music! *(If you are not playing next year, turn paper over for instructions on returning the rental)*
3. Keep coming to lessons until the end of the year

5th Grade, if you are playing Band/Strings in Middle School, we STRONGLY encourage you to keep your instrument over the summer. We may also be playing at the end of year celebration!!

***Reasons to keep playing over the summer:

- So that you don't forget how to play!

Even if you only practice on the rainy days during the summer, you will be keeping those playing muscles (physical and mental) in shape for next year;

- To save your parents money!

Instruments rented from Elefante Music and The Music Shop are rent-to-own.

Contact the store to find out more information;

- So that we can start playing in September!

If you return your instrument now and re-rent in the Fall, you will have to wait until the instruments are delivered in October.

Not playing next year/Returning your instrument?

1. Please call The Music Shop or Elefante Music to request a return authorization number.
2. Write that number on a piece of paper and tape it to the OUTSIDE of the instrument case.
3. Once the return authorization number is taped to the case, return the instrument to Mr. Mulcahy or Miss Maliszewski for pick-up.

If this procedure is not followed, additional fees may result! Remember: the rental contract is between the parent and vendor. Please call the vendor with any problems or questions.
